

## **Ball Presentation Guide**

The colors on the CCC<sup>™</sup> balls help to tell the story of how God wants to have a relationship with us. By using the following guide, we can show others the love of God in a visual manner.

BLUE	God is the One who has created the blue heavens and blue seas. Out of His great love, He also created us to have a love relationship with Him.  In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Genesis 1:1
GOLD	God loves us so much that He wants our relationship with Him to last forever in a place called Heaven. The Bible says that the street in heaven was pure gold and is a place with no more crying, pain, suffering, or dying.  And the street of the city was pure gold, like transparent glass. Revelation 21:21
DARK	God is a holy God, and we are not a holy people. We were born in sin and continue to live in sin. We lie, cheat, steal, and disobey God. The Bible says that our sin separates us from God.
	For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. Romans 3:23
RED	God's love for us is so great that He sent His only Son to earth to die on the cross to pay the penalty for our sins. Red represents the blood He shed when He died, and it reminds us that our "sin-debt" has been paid in full.
	For the wages of sin is death, but the gracious gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23
WHITE	God said he will forgive us and make our sins white as snow if we will receive Jesus as our Savior.
	If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. Romans 10:9
